Program Description: Florida International University's Haitian Summer Institute is organized by the university's Latin American and Caribbean Center in conjunction with the Center for Latin American Studies at the University of Florida. The program is designed for anyone interested in acquiring basic conversational proficiency in Haitian Creole and an understanding of Haitian culture. The six-week program is divided into two parts: Accelerated Beginning Haitian Creole is taught for the first three weeks, and Intermediate Accelerated Haitian Creole is taught in the final three weeks. Classes generally run from 9:30 am to 12 noon and 1 pm to 3:30 pm, Monday through Friday. The institute is held at Florida International University's University Park Campus and takes advantage of FIU's location in Miami, home to a vibrant Haitian community.
